

The Adelaide Camera Club is well known for its workshops and as a member you have the opportunity to participate in the workshops for a very small fee. Our models are usually either friends of club members or aspiring models from agencies. The models are giving their time in return for some photos and to gain some experience. The workshops should be a fun time for both the photographer and the model. Please follow the following simple rules:





- 1. At the workshop, introduce yourself to the model. Talk to the model and try and convey how you want them to pose.
- 2. Do not touch the model.
- 3. Allow fellow members to have a turn photographing the model.
- 4. **Do not** ask the model for any contact details including telephone number, email address or postal address. Do not attempt to get contact details on pretext of giving them a set of photos.
- 5. **Do not** ask the model for a model release. The club will hold the model release so that the photos taken during the club shoot can be used for non profit purposes by the club and members.
- 6. Do not attempt to arrange a separate photo session with the model. If you wish to do have a photo session speak to the workshop director and he/she will discuss it with the model.
